

LOTTERY UPDATE – Autumn 2017

By the end of September the lottery had paid out a total of £7850 in prize money and almost £7500 on various projects including the Mark Harrod dugouts, social club shutters, medical supplies, pitch maintenance, car park improvements and updating the telephone system. We currently have over £10,000 in the bank after payment of October's prizes towards future projects.

It is vitally important that the lottery continues to grow in order to raise extra funds for important ground improvement projects such as creating a changing room for female match officials (which will soon be compulsory under Evostik League rules) and essential repair work to the changing room block.

Membership of the lottery currently stands at 258 and the prize fund percentage payout is approximately 40% of total monthly income. We currently have 3 prizes each month of £500, £100 and £50. If you are not already a member of our exciting lottery why not join by completing a standing order mandate? The minimum amount is only £5 a month and for each £1 you will be allocated one unique lottery number.

In an effort to increase membership we launched an agents scheme earlier this year. Agents commission is a generous 30% so for every 10 new members paying the minimum amount of £5 a month the agent receives commission of £15 each month for as long as the members mandates remain active. In addition, if an agent raises £2500 in a 12 months period, they will receive a bonus of £250. Please help us 'Boost the Boro' by joining the lottery or becoming an agent.
